Fees and Policies

- **Night / Weekend / Holiday Fee: \$50.** Holidays: New Year's Day, MLK Jr. Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, Day after Thanksgiving, Christmas Day.
- **Cancellations and No-Show / Missed Appointments:**
 - Rescheduling within 48 hours of your visit is considered a cancellation.
 - More than 48 hours' notice: no fee, unless there is a history of chronic rescheduling, in which case a \$15 fee may apply.
 - Less than 48 hours: \$50 (visits over 30 min), \$15 (30 min visit), \$50 (Combo Lactation / Chiropractic).
 - Less than 24 hours: \$100 (visits over 30 min), \$30 (30 min visit), \$100 (Combo Lactation / Chiropractic).
 - No-show / missed appointment: the full visit fee (Full Rate).
 - If you are unable to attend due to illness or an emergency, the cancellation fee may be waived as long as the appointment is rescheduled and takes place within 10 days.

Chiropractic and PBM Therapy

At Bayou City Breastfeeding, we offer two optional services that support infant feeding and recovery: chiropractic care and TenderCare PBM™ light therapy. Both work alongside your lactation care, not in place of it.

Chiropractic Care

Our pediatric-trained chiropractors use gentle, low-force adjustments suited to both infants and adults. For babies, this can ease tightness or restricted movement that makes latching, turning the head, or feeding comfortably more difficult. For nursing parents, it can relieve the neck, back, and jaw strain that often comes with feeding and holding a newborn. For expecting parents, we also offer prenatal chiropractic using the Webster Technique, a gentle approach focused on pelvic balance and comfort during pregnancy.

Chiropractic care works best alongside lactation support, addressing the physical tension that can sit underneath a feeding problem. If you think it might help, ask your IBCLC or a member of our team.

TenderCare PBM™ Light Therapy (Photobiomodulation)

PBM therapy uses Class III/IV medical lasers to deliver specific wavelengths of light that support healing, reduce inflammation, and ease discomfort. It is non-invasive and painless. Because each person responds differently, more than one session may be needed. PBM is available at our Kingwood, Houston, Jones, and Katy offices.

The conditions below are treated with light therapy, not chiropractic:

PBM for Adults

- **Lactation Support:** Building milk supply and managing plugged ducts and mastitis.
- **Nipple Recovery:** Healing sore, cracked, or bleeding nipples.
- **Pain Management:** TMJ discomfort, nursing wrist, muscle pain, and joint pain.
- **Inflammation:** Engorgement, ear pain, and sinus relief.
- **Healing Support:** Mouth ulcers, cold sores, and scar tissue.

PBM for Babies

- **Birth Trauma:** Eases birth-related stress and general discomfort in newborns.
- **Torticollis and Muscle Tightness:** Relieves tightness to improve flexibility and comfort.
- **Oral Care:** Supports recovery before and after a frenectomy.
- **Digestive and Skin Health:** Soothes GI discomfort and skin conditions like eczema.
- **Sleep:** Encourages restful sleep by easing discomfort.
